





The GEMBA program is ideal for individuals who have strong international experience and a drive to make a difference in their organizations. Participants expand their knowledge, organizational leadership skills, and ability to solve complex business problems.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Curriculum is optimized for mid-career professionals with international experience.
- Accelerated full-time program for one-year completion minimizes time away from work. Classes take place June 20, 2023 June 7, 2024.
