Q: What is special about your MBA program? In addition to its' excellent reputation, what differentiates it from other Top MBA programs?

A: We hold the triple crown accreditation in Germany and studying Mannheim will put you among

Q: Can you share some details about the atmosphere in the school? Amongst the students? Between students and faculty? How do students spend their free time?

A: Being in a small cohort, the class is close knit, and they do a lot of activities together such as excursions, birthday parties, and sports.

Q: Can you share some details about the area the school is located in?

A: Mannheim is a mid size city in Germany with a population of 300,000 people. The campus has a city centre location where most students take a 10 to 15 mins walk from their student housing. The city itself has great access to Frankfurt airport and major European and German cities.

Q: Can you share some details regarding job opportunities and summer internships for students in your school?

A: Students can choose to do an internship for 3 months from September to December if they choose to. Job opportunities are at an abundance in a job market of 80 million people across large companies and small and medium sized businesses. Job opportunities also vary on the individuals' experience, and expectations.

Q: What is it that you are looking for in a candidate? Who will especially enjoy this school? who will be a good fit to the school?

A: We look for a candidate who comes with an open mind and a collaborative mindset to work with others.

Q: One most important piece of advice for an applicant based on your experience?

A: Come with an open mind and you will be surprised. We are impressed by candidates who will do good research on the program and job market prior to the interview. It also helps the candidate to target what kind of roles they would like to aim in the job market after graduation. Of course, we are there to give pointers but we would like to know as well where they would like to end up after graduation. 😊

Q: Are later rounds worth considering?

A: Yes, you can also apply late provided you already have a gmat or gre score ready.

Q: GMAT and importance as a % of the candidacy? What is the minimum GMAT you are looking for?

A: We require a gmat focus score of 575 or equivalent at the time of application.



Q: Is there anything you'd like our candidates to know regarding the admissions process?

A: Our admissions process includes 2 interviews. One will be with the admissions manager and another will be with our career development team where you will also discuss a case study.

Q: Can you tell us more about funding – scholarship/fellowship options in your school?

A: We are currently running an industry diversity scholarship where the first three applicants representing an industry will qualify for €3000 award. Among others, we have 2 early bird rounds and scholarships such as Women in Business and Outstanding Candidate categories. If you are searching for an education loan, we work with prodigy finance, brain capital and lendwise.

Q: Can you share some information about partners who are joining the student-Employment options for him/her? What are the visa requirements?

A: Visa provisions for partners and spouses varies on case by case basis. The participant needs to check with the embassy on the requirements.
