A: We support Israeli students in securing work opportunities in the NYC region through our Professional Career Track

A: Academically focused, entrepreneurial, open minded

A: Stay focused on your studies, start networking and building your contacts in the NYC region

A: Negotiate for scholarship funds

A: GMAT is recommended but not required

Q: Any tips for Israeli applicants considering applying to your school?

A: For September 2024, complete application by July 1st.

Q: Can you tell us more about funding – scholarship/fellowship options in your school?

A: Every Israeli student receives a 20% tuition reduction

Q: Can you share some information about partners who are joining the student-Employment options for him/her? What are the visa requirements?

A: Students can do both CPT and OPT work opportunities on their visa.
